



Nutcracker 2016

Informational Packet

This packet has all of the information pertaining to our Nutcracker Performances.
Please read the material carefully so that all of your questions can be answered.

The Portsmouth School of Ballet will be performing *The Nutcracker* on Saturday, December 3rd at 5:00 pm (Red Cast) and Sunday, December 4th at 10:00 am (Green Cast) & Sunday, December 4th at 3:00 pm (Blue Cast) at the Exeter High School Auditorium.

The casting for the Portsmouth School of Ballet's students is as follows:

Ballet I – VII:

Students in Ballet I – VII will be performing in all three performances of *The Nutcracker*. Saturday Ballet I/II students performing as Reindeer and Saturday Ballet III/IV students are done performing at intermission and can be picked up backstage. We encourage them to stay and watch the remainder of the performance; the participating dancers do not need to purchase a ticket. All other parts will remain backstage for the duration of the performance and will be picked up after the show.

Foundation:

*Tuesday Foundation (Red cast) will be performing in the Saturday, December 3rd performance at 5:00 pm.

*Friday Foundation (Green cast) will be performing in the Sunday, December 4th performance 10:00 am.

* Saturday Foundation (Blue cast) will perform in the Sunday, December 4th performance at 3:00 pm. All Foundation classes will be performing as Dolls and will be performing in the first act only. They can be picked up backstage at intermission. We encourage Foundation students to stay and watch the remainder of the performance; they do not need to purchase a ticket.

Pre-Ballet I and II:

All Pre-Ballet I and II students will perform on Sunday December 4th in either the 10:00 am show or the 3:00 pm show.

***ALL** Tuesday, Thursday Pre Ballet I and Pre Ballet II classes and **ONLY** the Friday Morning Pre-Ballet I and Pre-Ballet II classes will perform in the 10:00am show (Green cast).

*Friday AFTERNOON and Saturday Pre-Ballet I and Pre-Ballet II classes will perform in the 3:00pm show (Blue Cast).

Pre-Ballet students will be finished performing at intermission and will be dismissed at intermission from the front of the stage into the theatre. We encourage all Pre-Ballet students to stay and watch the remainder of the performance; they do not need to purchase a ticket.

*****A reminder that fall semester classes will continue through January 20th, 2017. The school will be closed for a holiday break from Saturday, December 24th – Sunday, January 8th and then resume classes Monday, January 9th -Saturday, January 20th. We will begin our Winter/Spring Semester on Monday, January 30th 2017.*****

Tickets can be purchased in the office or over the phone. The auditorium is general admission seating. Tickets are \$17 for Adults & \$15 for Children ages 12 – under & senior citizens over the age of 65. A ticket for two performances of *The Nutcracker* for the same person can be purchased for \$30 for Adults & \$26 for Children & Seniors. If the same person is attending all 3 performances, their third ticket will be \$5. *It must be for the same person attending the performances to receive this discount.* We often sell out performances of the school's Nutcracker, so we ask that you please purchase your tickets in advance. We cannot guarantee that tickets will be available for purchase at the door the day of the performance. **All ticket sales are final.** The school cannot exchange or refund money for the purchase of tickets, so please make sure you know exactly how many tickets you need to purchase in advance. There is no limit on the number of tickets available for purchase. **We only accept Cash and Check for tickets sold at the Theater.**

Directions. Take I-95 South to Rt – 101 Exit 2 toward Exeter/Hampton. Merge onto NH-101 W towards Manchester/Concord. Continue on 101 to Exit 9. Turn right at the end of the exit onto NH-27 Epping Rd. Follow for 1.7 miles to Exeter High School Auditorium. Exeter High School is located at 315 Epping Rd, Exeter NH 03833.

Seating. The theater is general admission; there is no advanced seating for the auditorium. The theater holds approximately one thousand people and all seats in the auditorium have excellent viewing. We ask that you do not save seats, so please arrive with your entire party and then be seated. Please remain seated during the performance. If you have to leave the auditorium, please do so during a pause in the program. Baby carriages and car seats are not permitted in the auditorium. No one is allowed to sit, stand or place any items in the aisles as aisles must remain clear.

Cameras & Video Cameras are NOT permitted during the performances for the safety of your children and the dancers. Flashes can be blinding onstage and the use of cameras is distracting to other audience members. Pictures can be taken before or after the performances only.

****DVD's of each performance are available for purchase in the office or at the theater the day of the show. To pre-order your Nutcracker DVD please fill out the order form on the last page of this packet and turn into the office or at the ticket booth by December 4th****

****NEW this year, we will be offering pictures for purchase of the performance you can order online a couple of weeks after the show. ****

Flowers are available for purchase at all three performances. Flowers will be available until the end of intermission. Flowers are priced per stem and start at \$1.50. There is no minimum and loose bouquets can be done in any price range. **Cash or Check is all that can be accepted the day of the performance.**

Gifts- Gifts and refreshments are offered at the performances by the Portsmouth School of Ballet Student Company. Please make sure to stop by and help out these hard working dancers and their families. Proceeds go towards their Competition fees. They only accept Cash at the performances.

Volunteers (NEW sign up process)- We need volunteers to stay with the students backstage, ushers for the auditorium and men to work back stage with tech. If you are interested in volunteering, we ask that you please sign up to Volunteer on the sign up sheet in the lobby from November 1st- November 25th. This sign up process is on a first come first served basis. We mostly need parent volunteers to be backstage with the students from every group. You will be there to help take bathroom breaks and keep the students entertained while they are waiting backstage to dance. If you are volunteering, you must wait with the students of the group you are volunteering with until all students have been picked up by a parent at the end of the show. Sometimes, the students wait a long time backstage, and they need things to do. Some fun ideas for Volunteers backstage, you can bring coloring books and crayons (no markers), balloons, pipe-cleaners, beads, and yarn to make bracelets. Food is okay to bring backstage as long as there are NO peanuts or peanut products. Please do not allow the dancers to eat food in their costumes. Cheez-Its are okay as long as there is no cheese powder. Fruit snacks and water are great. When the

children are done, we need help hanging costumes back up and making sure the dressing rooms are completely picked up. We also need Ushers at the front of the theater to take tickets.

Hair must be worn in a bun for girls and slicked neatly back with gel for boys. We ask that all bangs and wispy hair strands are slicked back with gel and hair spray. Please use bobby pins and hair pins with a hair net that matches their hair color to make a bun. *Small bun kits are available for purchase in the office for \$5.* If a student arrives to the performance without their hair in a bun we cannot allow them to perform.

Makeup is optional for all of the Pre-Ballet and Foundation students. We will not be putting any additional makeup on students, only what is needed for their costume (i.e. red felt cheeks on soldier's faces, whiskers on baby mice). We will not put blush, eyeliners, eye shadows, mascaras or any other type of makeup on a student. If a parent would like to put makeup on their child we ask that you please apply the makeup before the student arrives and please use earth tones such as browns and whites. Please no pink, it loses its tone under stage lights.

We have a bun/hair and make-up video up on YouTube.com. You can search "Portsmouth School of Ballet Bun" and "Portsmouth School of Ballet Stage Makeup" to find these video tutorials.

Performance Attire

Listed below is what each class is required to wear with their costume to perform.

Pre-Ballet I & II, Baby Mice – Girls wear a plain pink leotard (long sleeve is recommended) with **no skirts or tutus**, pink ballet tights and pink ballet slippers. Boys wear their black pants, white t-shirts, black socks and black ballet slippers. They will receive their costumes when they arrive to perform and leave with the costumes.

Foundation, Dolls – Girls wear the pink leotards they wear to class, pink ballet tights, ballet buns, and pink ballet slippers. **The costumes belong to the school and the students will wear them to perform in only.**

Ballet I Wednesday & Thursday, Polichinelles - Wear what they wear to class each week, burgundy leotard, pink tights and pink ballet slippers. Please have your child's hair in a high bun at the crown of their head so we can pin their hats on. Boys will wear their regular class attire. Please bring bobby pins for the hats. **The costumes belong to the school and the students will wear them to perform in only.**

Ballet I/II Saturday, Reindeer – Girls will wear a skin colored camisole leotard, pink tights and pink ballet slippers. Please have your child's hair in a bun. Please bring bobby pins for the antlers. **The costumes belong to the school and the students will wear them to perform in only.**

Ballet II Wednesday, Chinese – A black camisole leotard, pink tights and pink ballet slippers. Do not wear a long sleeved leotard, it will be seen under the costume. **The costumes belongs to the school and the students will wear them to perform in only.**

Ballet II Thursday, Spanish – Wear their pink tights and pink ballet slippers only. We ask that all students please wear a skin colored camisole leotard under their costume. If you have questions about this please call the office. **The costumes belong to the school and the students will wear them to perform in only.**

Ballet III Wednesday, Arabian – Wear their pink tights and pink ballet slippers. We ask that they wear a skin colored camisole leotard with their costume. If you have questions about this please call the office.

The costumes belong to the school and the students will wear them to perform in only. Boys talk to Ms. Megan.

Ballet III/IV Thursday, Angels - Wear their pink tights and pink ballet slippers only. We ask that all students please wear a skin colored camisole leotard under their costume because they are white costumes. If you have questions about this please call the office. **The costumes belong to the school and the students will wear them to perform in only. Boys talk to Ms. Megan.**

Ballet III/IV Saturday, Snowflakes - Wear their pink tights and pink ballet slippers only. We ask that all students please wear a skin colored camisole leotard under their costume because they are white costumes. If you have questions about this please call the office. **The costumes belong to the school and the students will wear them to perform in only. .**

Ballet IV Wednesday, Candy Cane/Ribbon Candy – Wear their pink tights and pink ballet slippers. We ask that they wear a skin colored camisole leotard with their costume. If you have questions about this please call the office. **The costumes belong to the school and the students will wear them to perform in only.**

Ballet V Tuesday, Big Mice/Soldiers/Russian- Wear a skin colored camisole leotard for Soldiers, and a black camisole leotard for Big Mice AND Russian, pink ballet meshed seamed tights (Capezio Classic Pink #9) and pink ballet slippers. **The costumes belong to the school and the students will wear them to perform in only. Boys talk to Ms. Megan.**

Ballet VI, Angels and Flowers - Wear a skin colored camisole leotard, pink ballet meshed seamed tights and pointe shoes. Please purchase (Capezio Classic Pink #9) tights to perform in. **The costumes belong to the school and the students will wear them to perform in only.**

Ballet VII, Flowers/Snow and any additional roles- Wear a skin colored camisole leotard, pink ballet meshed seamed tights and pointe shoes. Please purchase (Capezio Classic Pink #9) tights to perform in. **The costumes belong to the school and the students will wear them to perform in only.**
